### Services provided by the Occupational Therapist

#### WHAT SERVICES CAN YOU EXPECT FOR YOUR CHILD?

-Formal and informal assessments.

-Individually designed plans, programs, and goals based on your child's needs.

-Classroom suggestions and assistance, as needed. Cross training of classroom team and parents to increase effectiveness of occupational therapy services.

-Treatment may include techniques to:

- -improve strength, endurance,, coordination, and posture.
- improve fine motor skills for grasp and visual motor integration
- improve body awareness, motor planning and self organization
- improve feeding/oral motor skills

### Additionally your Occupational Therapist may:

-Communicate and coordinate services with outside therapists or other medical services.

-Provide parent consultation, training, support, resources, education , and linkage to other agencies

-Attend clinic/medical appointments as needed.
